- 1. Release Form should be attached to back of poster
- 2. The contest is for fifth grade students, from public or private schools. All entries must be original artwork. A student may enter the contest only once.
- 3. Entries may be done in marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, regular/colored pencil, and/or tempera paint.
- 4. Computer or photo generated art and/or printing is not acceptable.
- 5. Entries should not display the names of commercial products, companies, or organizations.
- 8. Poster size must be between 8.5" x 11" and 22" x 28".
- 9. The contest theme must be on the poster and spelled correctly.
- 10. Entries should not be matted, mounted, laminated, or framed.
- 11. Each county will have a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner. The 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will go on to compete and the statewide level. There will be three Statewide Winners who will receive a tree planting at the school with:

1st - 15 trees 2nd - 10 trees 3rd - 5 trees
