# Minutes for Montgomery County Forestry Board Meeting on October 11, 2022.

Meeting called to order at 1:35 by Chair Jim Harris.

Last meeting minutes were approved with corrections: Joe Howard received more than two paper copies of the Maryland Big Tree Champion Tree Register for 2021-2022.

#### Treasurer's Report

There was no activity in the account's balance since September 13, 2022; the balance is \$2,868.51 as of October 11, 2022.

#### Chair's Report

Jim Harris suggested that Paula Perez be invited to join the Montgomery County Forestry Board to represent the city of Rockville. There was a motion to grant Linda Pepe emerita status from Jim Harris, and the motion passed unanimously. Linda was then presented with a book titled *Around the World in 80 Trees* by Jonathan Drori, and illustrated by Lucille Clerc.

#### Legislative Report

No legislative news was reported.

#### **DNR Report**

Interviews for the vacant ranger position for Howard and Montgomery counties have concluded, however no candidate has selected the position as of October 11, 2022. No significant details pertaining to the 5 Million Trees project were reported.

Tree planting will continue in the spring 2023.

#### **New Business**

Joe Howard presented a motion to nominate Lee Derby as a new member of the Montgomery County Forestry Board, and the motion passed unanimously. Lee is an instructor of environmental education for Montgomery County Public Schools. A motion to re-induct Brett Linkletter as an active member of the Montgomery Country Forestry Board was also presented, and the motion passed unanimously. Brett is the Chief of Tree Maintenance for Montgomery County. Jim Harris noted that he will initiate contact with Paula Perez to invite her board membership.

### **Old Business**

The fees for NRCC attendance have increased. The tuition fee has increased from \$450 to \$500 per camper, and the activity fee has increased from \$125 to \$150 per camper. Funds will be petitioned from the Izaak Walton League, Ashton Manor Environmental, and Pepco. Joli McCathran mentioned that 15 checks of the Maryland Urban and Community Forest Committee
