Complete the native plant scavenger hunt (found at the MD Conservation Corps table)	Ask a volunteer from the Friends of New Germany what they like most about the park	Get a family photo in the native plant garden (please stay on the walkway)	Learn the scientific name for Eastern White Pine (Hint: look for a labeled tree near the beach)	Visit the Evergreen Heritage Center and learn the name of at least one native plant they have for sale
Visit the Nature Center and learn why garlic mustard is a harmful invasive plant	Visit the Native Plant Garden and learn the common name for <i>Tiarella cordifolia</i>	Visit Marta Fiscus Photography and find at least one photograph with an insect	Participate in a guided nature walk	Ask a member of the Maryland Native Plant Society about their favorite native wildflower
Visit Wood Thrush Native Plant Nursery and learn the name of at least one plant they have for sale	Learn what you can do to help stop the spread of invasive plants in the lake (Hint: read the signs at the boat ramp)	FREE	Ask a Maryland Conservation Corps member about their favorite assignment in Maryland State Parks	Visit Peggy Nixon Designs and ask her the color of her favorite bird
Ask a representative from Garrett Trails about their favorite trail in Garrett County	Visit Tree Talk Natives and learn the name of at least one native plant they have for sale	Find a hemlock tree with a silver tag, and then ask a Maryland Conservation Corps member what that tag means	Learn the name of a deciduous conifer that drops its needles in the fall (Hint: this is also the name of a pavilion in the park)	Visit Keen and Bright and find three nature-themed glass objects
Ask a park ranger about their favorite outdoor activity	Read the interpretive signage about the Civilian Conservation Corps by the Rec Hall and inside the Lake House	Ask a member of Trout Unlimited about their favorite place to fish in Garrett County	Visit Appalachian Wax Works and learn three things that can be made from beeswax	Ask a Garrett County Master Gardener what they would recommend you plant at home to attract pollinators
