## Option 1- Re-potting efforts

If you're interested in **learning about nursery plant production and invasive Asian jumping worms**...this might be the choice for you!

Slow the spread of this [invasive pest](#) by helping to remove potentially contaminated soil, washing pots and plant roots, and then repotting into clean soil.



## Option 2- Demonstration garden

If you're interested in **learning about plant care and weed management**...this might be the choice for you!

Help keep the gardens thriving by performing routine maintenance. Demonstration gardens help educate and inspire guests on the [use of native plants](#) in their specific growing region.



## Option 3- Purchasing native plants

If you're interested in **attracting wildlife** to your yard by providing appropriate food and shelter...this might be the choice for you!

Find and purchase the right plant for the right place. The [online store](#) is open Sundays 9am- Tuesdays 9pm. Contactless pickup is then scheduled for Thursday- Friday 10am-3pm or Saturday 10am-1pm.
