
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## **Get Hooked: A Fishing Quest**

- 7-10 inches in length. Silvery greenish color body with faint black lines on each side. Highly domed gray or black back
- 6-9 Horizontal stripes on each side. White or silver belly. Is also the state fish of Maryland.
- Blueish to olive green body color with bright blue claws.Also a top creature Maryland is known for.
- Dark gray or green back with silvery white belly. Has distinct round spots on its back and fins.
- 10. Both of its eyes appear on the same side.
- Blueish to brown in color. Its name may sounds like a type of pet.
