## Wednesday, March 8 Martinak State Park 10:30 AM

## Wednesday March 22 Tuckahoe State Park 10:30 AM

Pee Wee's Trail is the goal for today's hike. Along this trail you will see a couple of champion trees as we meander along the creek. This is a 5 mile walk as we loop back via the Tuckahoe Valley Trail. We will meet at the Equestrian Loop Trail Parking Area on Crouse Mill Road. Meet at the Cemetery Road Parking Area off of Route 404 to hike the Creekside Cliff Trail, part of the Tuckahoe Valley Trail, and the Connector Trail. Some of the trail could be muddy or wet, but you won't be disappointed in the scenery. This will be a 5 mile hike. There are no restrooms at this location.
