

Low Watermilfoil *Myriophyllum humile*

Distribution - Native to Chesapeake Bay, mostly coastal in ponds and reservoirs.

Recognition - Plant stems very leafy. Leaves usually in whorls of 5 (mostly subopposite or scattered), all alike, 1-2.5 cm long with 6-10 hair-like segments per side.

Similar Species - Coontail (coarse, roughly divided leaves), and Eurasian Watermilfoil.

Reproduction - By seed and fragmentation.

Comments - Rare in Chesapeake Bay.
