Myrtle Grove WMA Shooting Range Daily Permit Instructions

- 1. A Range Permit is required of all users age 18 and over. Shooters under 18 must be accompanied by a permitted adult and posess a valid Hunter Safety Certificate.
- 2. Write your full name and today's date on both the envelope and permit. Detach the Permit and keep it in your possession while using the range.
- 3. Put posted daily permit fee (cash or check) in envelope, and insert in collection box slot. Make check payable to Maryland Department of Natural Resources.
- 4. If you possess a valid seasonal Myrtle Grove WMA Shooting Range Permit you DO NOT need a Daily Permit.

- There is a 1 hour time limit on shooting when people are waiting.
- Only paper targets that fit completely within the provided target stands may be used.
- Place Targets so that your rounds are striking the berm.
- Attaching targets to or shooting at any part of the baffle structures is prohibited.
- Check to be certain all shooters agree the range is cold before proceeding downrange to place or retrieve targets.
- Check to be certain all shooters agree the range is hot before handling, loading or shooting firearms.
- Eye and hearing protection is required.
